

Rev. Neal's Sermon Notes for Sunday, October 9, 2005

ἐκλεκτός (“Eklektos”) = chosen

From the greek root word: λέγω (“lego”) meaning “to say, to speak, to count, to gather”
And from the prefix: ἐκ (“ek”) meaning “out” or “from” or “out of”

ἐκ + λεγω = “to out call” or “call out” someone or something.

In English we get the word “ecclesiastical” from this greek word: of or having to deal with the
“church” ... from the Latin “ecclesia” and the Greek ἐκκλησία
